Print, cut, and fold three styles of beautiful crystal gems. Hang them from a light strand or in the window, or leave the top intact for a handheld or desktop crystal.

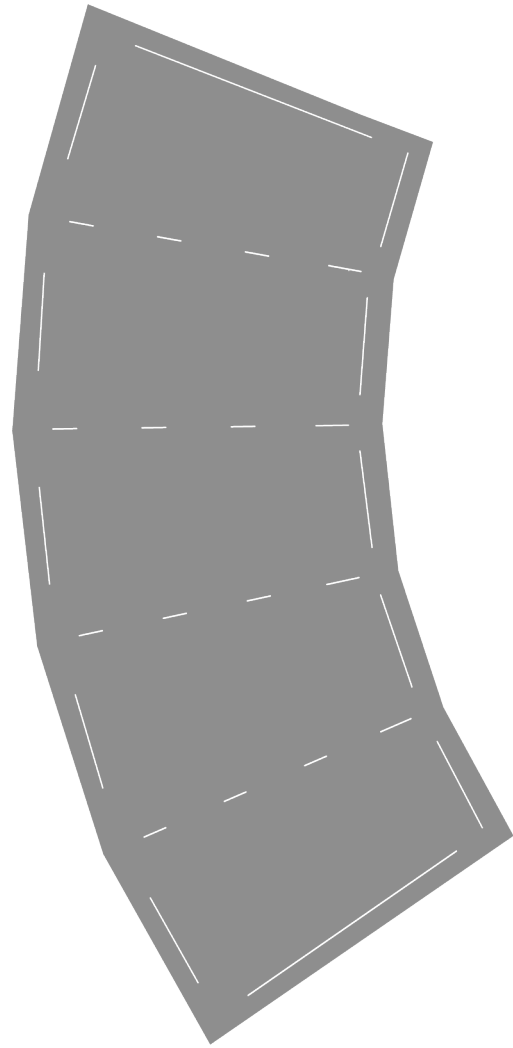
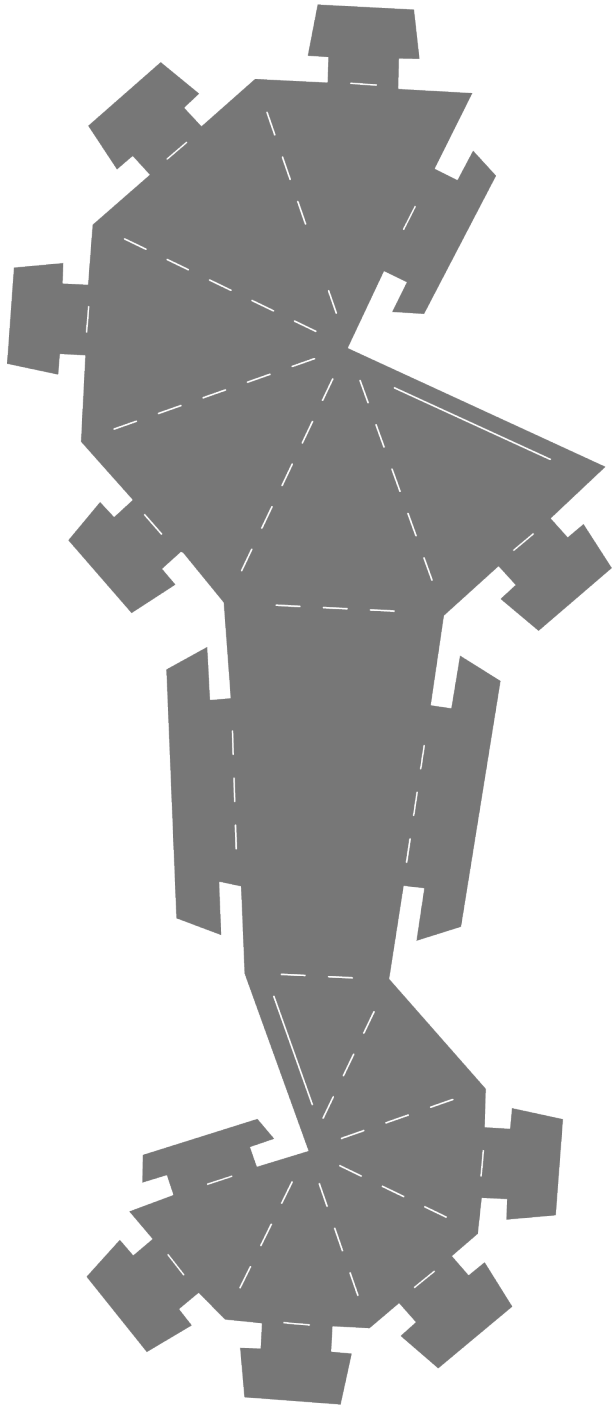
These gems will look great made from any stiff colored paper or card stock. My favorite material for a translucent, realistic crystal effect is laminated cellophane:

- Buy iridescent cellophane gift wrap from the craft or stationary store
- Cut it to letter size
- Run it through a standard laminating machine
- Add a piece of crumpled cellophane inside to make occlusions

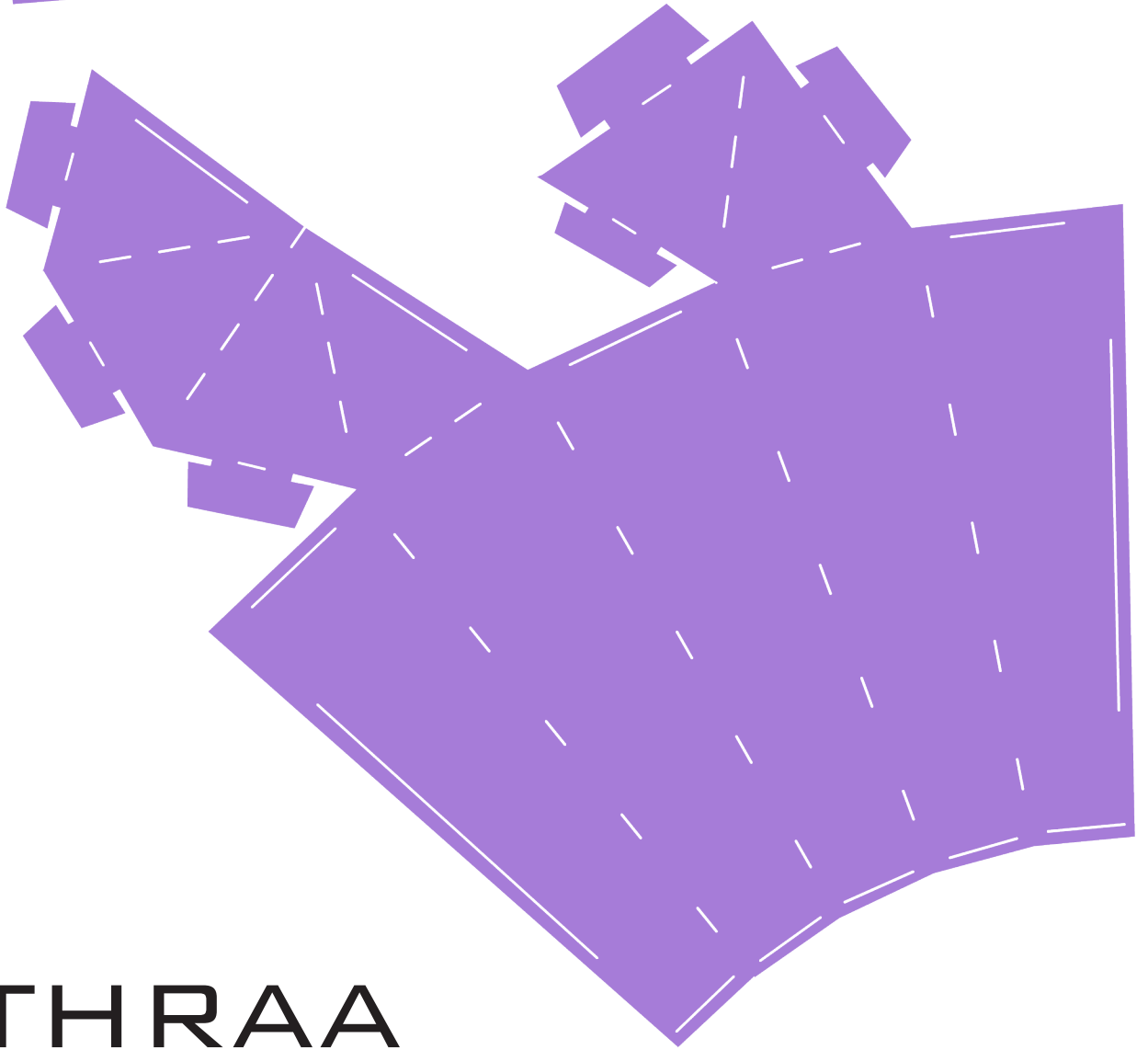
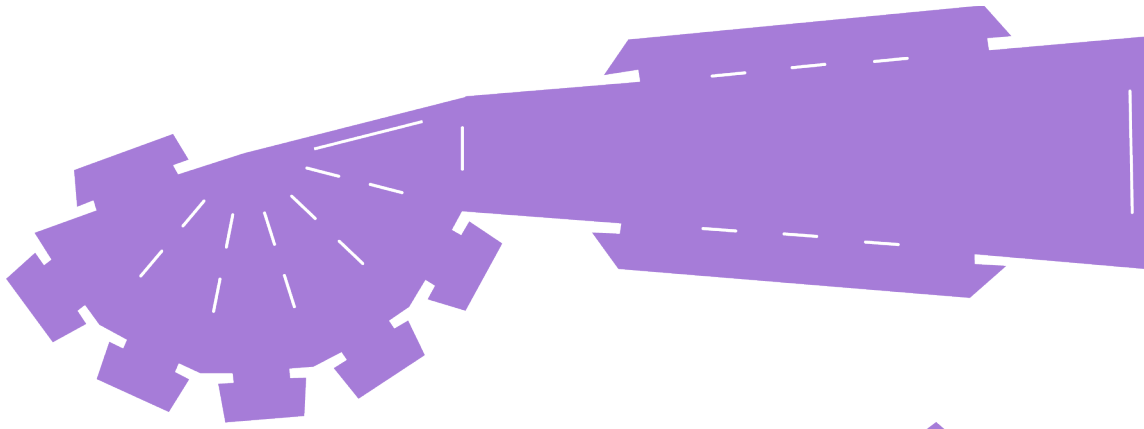
The gems can be cut by hand or with a vinyl cutting machine like a Cricut or Silhouette. Cut on the bold lines and crease firmly on the dashed lines. Slash the slots and slip the tabs inside.

Each gem has two parts which fit together to form one complete crystal.
